Samaritan counseling Center, founded in 1985, is a private center currently serving residents of Schenectady, Albany, Rensselaer and Saratoga counties at six area sites. Therapists are also located in satellite offices within four school systems, working with students (as well as with the student's teachers and family members) through "Project Pass", a program designed to assist young
